- Title***

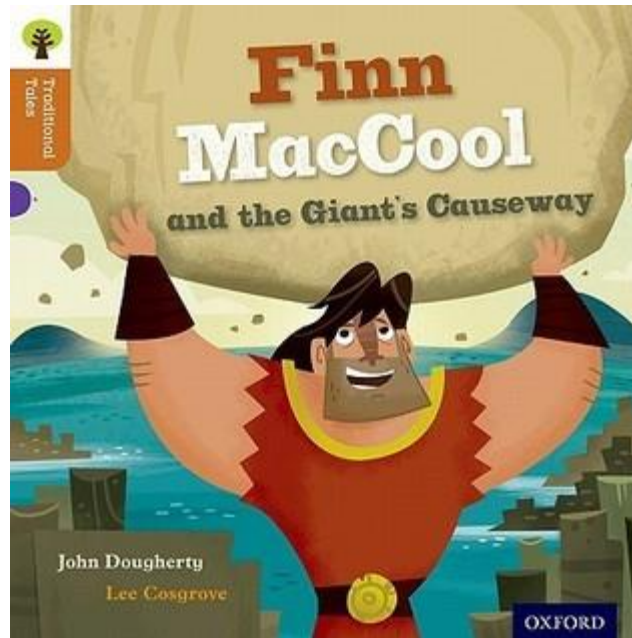
Presentation is very important - Make sure all sentences read correctly - Check spelling, grammar and punctuation.
